

Baccarat

How to Play

In Baccarat, players may choose to bet on one or more of the following outcomes: The Player Hand, The Banker Hand, or the Tie. Baccarat is usually played with eight (8) decks and The Player/Banker hand is dealt with two initial cards. To determine the value of the hand, cards are added together. Card values are as follows: Ace=1, King, Queen, Jack and Ten (10) = 0 and all other cards are face value. The highest hand with the value closest to nine (9) wins. If either the Player or Banker cards have a total of eight (8) or nine (9), both hands will stand. A third may or may not be dealt according to the following rule:

Player's first 2 cards total	Player will:	Banker will:
0-5	Draws one card	(please see table below)
6 & 7	Stand	Draw if Banker has 5 or less, Stand if Banker has 6 or more
Natural 8 or 9	Stand	(please see table below)

Banker's hand totals	Banker will draw when Player's third card is:	Banker will stand when Player's third card is:
1 or 2	any card	(always draws)
3	1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10	8
4	2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7	1, 8, 9, 10
5	4, 5, 6, 7	1, 2, 3, 8, 9, 10
6	6, 7	1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10
7	Stand	Stand
Natural 8 or 9	Stand	Stand
