

3 CARD

In this thrilling new game, compete heads-up against the dealer. You and the dealer each receive three cards to make the best hand.

HOW TO PLAY



Play begins by making the mandatory Ante bet. Both you and the dealer will then be dealt three cards.



After viewing your cards, you may fold or make a Play wager equal to your Ante wager. The dealer then reveals their cards, and the higher hand wins. Dealer must have at least Queen-high to qualify.



You may also make the optional Player Bonus wager. The Player Bonus wager pays if your three-card hand contains a pair or better.



You may also make the optional 6 Card Bounty wager. The 6 Card Bounty wager is based on your three-card hand combined with the dealer's three-card hand, and pays for a three-of-a-kind or better.

THREE CARD POKER

Three Card Poker progressive is an exciting stud poker game. You may bet against the dealer, bet on the value of your own three-card hand, or bet both. Bonus payouts may be had for certain hands when wagering against the dealer.

Pair PlusSM

Pair Plus side bet lets you bet against your own hand. If your hand contains a pair or better, you win!

Ante

Ante lets you play against the dealer's hand. It's just your cards against the dealer's. If you make an ante bet and like your hand, you must place an equal wager on the play spot. It's your hand against the dealer's poker hand, and the best hand wins!

To Play Both

It's you and your cards for a pair or better and it's you against the dealer for the best poker hand. You must also make the play wager or you will forfeit the ante wager.

Ante Bonus

If you make the ante and play wagers, you may win a bonus payout even if the dealer doesn't qualify, and even if the dealer's hand beats your hand.

Bad Beat Bonus

You have two ways to win if you are involved in a Bad Beat Bonus wager with the dealer. The first is by losing with a pair or better and the second is by beating the dealer's hand of a pair or better.

Progressive Payouts

The optional \$1 progressive bet wins if you have either a straight or a three-of-a-kind, depending on the payable offered by the casino. See payable for odds. If you receive an ace-king-queen of spades, you win 100% of the progressive jackpot. The optional progressive bet qualifies you for part or all of the incrementing jackpot. See payable for odds.

Envy Bonuses

Top pays trigger envy bonuses. See payable for payouts. You can win multiple envy bonuses in a round, but you cannot win envy bonuses for your own hand or the dealer's hand.
